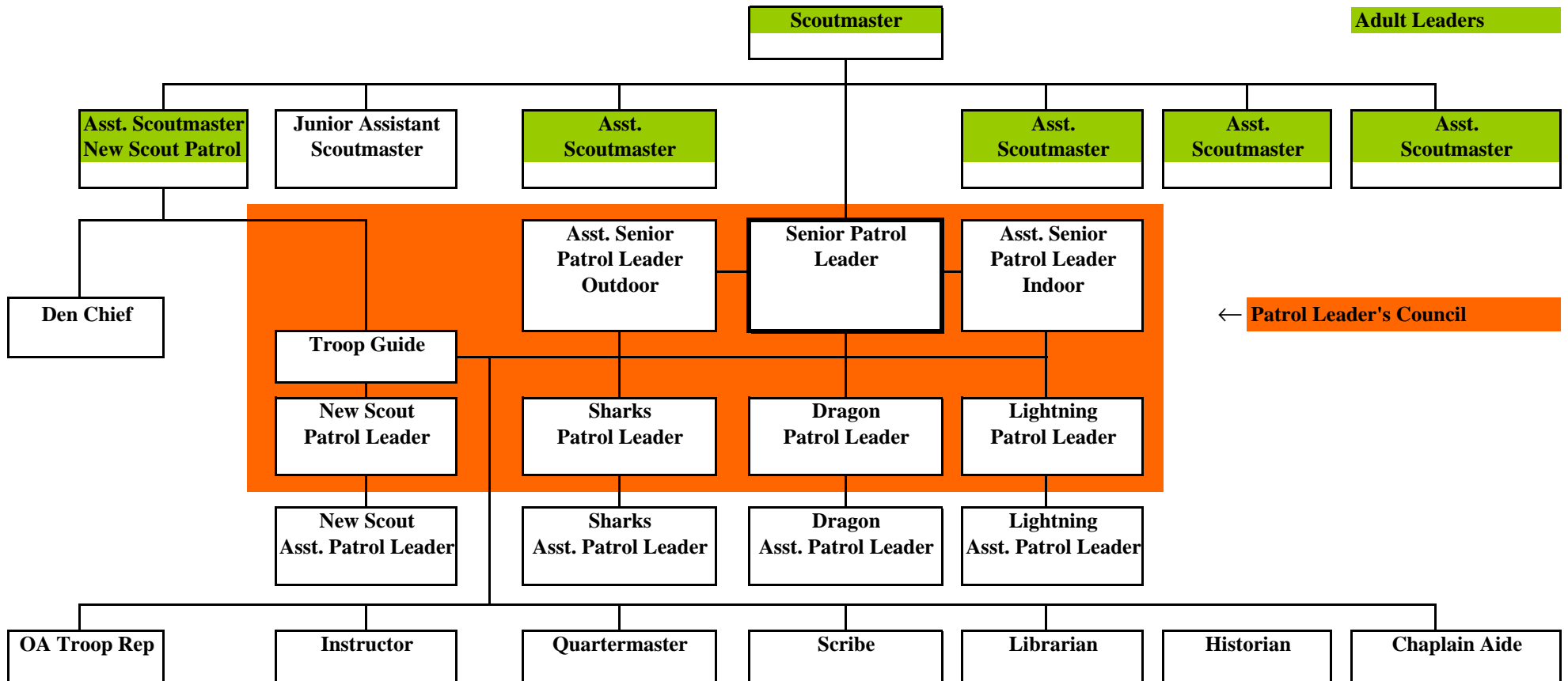


Troop 297 Youth Organizational Chart



Senior Patrol Leader

Run troop meetings, events, annual planning conference
Chair PLC
Appoint youth leaders
Delegate duties
Assist Scoutmaster
Set a good example
Wear uniform correctly
Show Scout Spirit
Communicate with Scoutmaster

Den Chief

Know purposes of Cub Scouting
Help Cubs advance
Assist with den meetings

ASPL Indoor

Assist SPL at troop meetings and indoor activities

ASPL Outdoor

Assist SPL at outdoor activities and meetings

Troop Guide

Introduce new Scouts to troop
Guide new Scouts through early troop activities
Teach basic Scout skills
Coach Patrol Leader of New Scout patrol
Attend PLC with patrol leader of New Scout Patrol

Patrol Leader

Appoint ASPL
Represent patrol at PLC
Plan and steer patrol meetings
Keep patrol informed

Asst. Patrol Leader

Assist Patrol Leader
Help patrol get ready for troop activities
Attend PLC if necessary

Quartermaster

Keep gear inventory
Check gear condition
Check gear in & out
Suggest replacements

OA Troop Rep

Attend monthly OA Chapter meetings & communicate with youth & adult OA members
Encourage participation in OA activities

Chaplain Aide

Assist Chaplain with religious services
Help plan religious observance at troop meetings & activities

Historian

Gather photos & facts about troop & keep in file or scrapbook

Instructor

Teach basic Scouting skills to troop & patrols

Librarian

Maintain troop library
Keep records of troop books & literature
Check books in and out
Follow up on late returns

Junior Asst Scoutmaster

Function as Asst Scoutmaster

Scribe

Keep & organize mailbox
Record discussions at PLC
Post minutes of PLC

Scoutmaster

Trains boys to be leaders
Provides resources
Provides guidance

Asst Scoutmaster

New Scout Patrol
Support Scoutmaster
Work with New Scout Patrol

Assistant Scoutmaster

Support & assist Scoutmaster
